The Volunteer understands that the Activities may include constructing, deconstructing, & rehabilitating buildings, working in the Habitat offices, moving and lifting goods in the resale store, working at special events, and living in housing provided for volunteers of Habitat.

The Volunteer hereby freely, voluntarily, and without duress executes this Release under the following terms:

1. Release and Waiver. Volunteer does hereby release and forever discharge and hold harmless Habitat and its successors and assigns from any and all liability, claims, and demands of whatever kind of nature, either in law or in equity, which arise or may hereafter arise from Volunteer's Activities with Habitat.

Volunteer understands that this Release discharges Habitat from any liability or claim that the Volunteer may have against Habitat with respect to any bodily injury, personal injury, illness, death, or property damage that may result from Volunteer's Activities with Habitat, whether caused by the negligence of Habitat or its officers, directors, employees, or agents or otherwise. Volunteer also understands that Habitat does not assume any responsibility for or obligation to provide financial assistance or other assistance, including but not limited to medical, health, or disability insurance in the event of injury or illness.

2. Medical Treatment. Volunteer does hereby release and forever discharge Habitat from any claim whatsoever which arises or may hereafter arise on account of any first aid, treatment, or service rendered in connection with the Volunteer's Activities with Habitat.

3. Assumption of the Risk. The Volunteer understands that the Activities include work that may be hazardous to the Volunteer, including, but not limited to, construction, loading and unloading, and transportation to and from the work sites.

Volunteer hereby expressly and specifically assumes the risk of injury or harm in the Activities and releases Habitat from all liability for injury, illness, death or property damage resulting from the Activities.

4. Insurance. The Volunteer understands that, except as otherwise agreed to by Habitat in writing; Habitat does not carry or maintain health, medical, or disability insurance coverage for any Volunteer. Each Volunteer is expected and encouraged to obtain his or her own medical or health insurance coverage.

5. Photographic Release. The Volunteer and Guardian desire that the Volunteer work as a volunteer for Habitat and engage in the activities related to being a volunteer (the "Activities"). The Volunteer and the Guardian understand that the Activities may include constructing, deconstructing, & rehabilitating buildings, working in the Habitat offices, moving and lifting goods in the resale store, working at special events, and living in housing provided for volunteers of Habitat.

The Volunteer and Guardian hereby freely, voluntarily, and without duress executes this Release under the following terms:

Volunteer and Guardian also understand that Habitat does not assume any responsibility for or obligation to provide financial assistance or other assistance, including but not limited to medical, health, or disability insurance in the event of injury or illness.

Volunteer and guardian understand and acknowledge that it is the policy of Habitat that children under the age of 16 not be allowed on a Habitat work site while there is construction in progress. It is further the policy of Habitat that, while children between the ages of 16 and 17 may perform general construction work, ultra hazardous activity such as using power tools, excavation, demolition, or working on rooftops is not permitted by anyone under the age of 18. Volunteer and guardian agree to abide by the aforementioned policies and agree that volunteer will only engage in those activities which are in compliance with said policies and which are directed, supervised, and overseen by a site supervisor designated by Habitat for Humanity of Greater New Bern.

2. Medical Treatment. Volunteer does hereby release and forever discharge Habitat from any claim whatsoever which arises or may hereafter arise on account of any first aid, treatment, or service rendered in connection with the Volunteer's Activities with Habitat.
